2018 PRELIMINARY DISTRICT AND SCHOOL PERFORMANCE FRAMEWORKS

Colorado Department of Education has preliminarily released ratings for schools and districts. The ratings are included in detailed performance framework reports that provide a great deal of data on schools and districts. The tentative schedule is for finalized performance frameworks to be published publicly in November (districts) and December (schools). The ratings themselves are intended to highlight schools and districts that are doing well and identify those that need improvement.

These frameworks help parents and communities understand specific, detailed information about academic performance of schools and districts with data that can be compared to other schools and districts around the state. The frameworks look at:

- Performance on statewide assessments in English language arts, math, science, and CO-PSAT/SAT.
- Growth from year to year on English language arts, math, CO-PSAT to SAT assessments as well as growth by English language learners on the ACCESS tests.
- Secondary schools' graduation rates, dropout rates, matriculation rates and college entrance exam scores.

All of this is combined into an overall accountability score report every year for the schools and districts.

The 2018 performance ratings are below:

Fremont Elementary School 2018: Performance Plan

Penrose Elementary School 2018: Priority Improvement*

Fremont Middle School 2018: Improvement Plan*

Fremont High School 2018: Improvement Plan*
